


Grow your Funds with a CD!

- Reduce Credit Card Balances: Keep credit utilization below 30% of your limit. Paying down high-interest debt can improve your score.
- Diversify Credit: A mix of credit types (credit cards, loans) helps your score, but don't take on unnecessary debt.

- Limit New Credit Applications: Too many credit inquiries can hurt your score. Do your research ahead of time and apply for new credit sparingly.
- Use Secured Cards or Loans: If you're new to credit, or trying to reestablish credit, these options can help build a positive credit history.
